Melville	two miles west of Rancho Santa Rosa on the northern side of Highway 246 with southern exposures	chardonnay - planted in 1998 on sand to clone 76; pinot noir - planted in 1997 on clay on the windy, western edge of the estate to clones 115 and 114; tight 8 x 3 spacing	owned and farmed by the Melville Family	Ojai, Bonaccorsi, Whitcraft, Melville
Clos Pepe	.25 miles west of Melville on the northern side of Highway 246 with southern exposures	planted in 1997 and 1998 on sandy clay loam, BC gets 1 acre of Wente clone chardonnay and 1 acre of Pommard clone pinot noir	owned and farmed by the Pepe Family and Wes Hagen, Jeff Newton consults	Ojai, Siduri, Loring, Clos Pepe
Ashley's	across the street from Clos Pepe on the southern side of Highway 246, BC's two sites come from the windy, extreme western edge of this vineyard	a 240 acre ranch planted in 1999 with several different aspects and exposures, BC gets Mt. Eden clone chardonnay and clone 115 and 114 pinot noir; tight 8 x 4 spacing on the hilltop	owned by Fess Parker and farmed by John Belfy	Fess Parker, Tantara, Testarossa, Drew, Bruno
Cargasacchi	on the Santa Rosa Road side of the mountains just west of Ashley's	16 acres planted in 1998 to only pinot noir clone 115, soils are diatomaceous and other calcareous materials, BC has a two acre section	owned and farmed by Peter Cargasacchi (Car - ga - sa - key)	Babcock, ABC, Bonaccorsi, Siduri
Sweeney Canyon	immediately east of Cargasacchi right above the Santa Ynez River, longest running vineyard site that BC sources fruit from	planted in the early 1980's, one of SB County's oldest vineyards, chardonnay is probably of Wente origin, soil is silty river deposits and diatomaceous earth. BC has a 8 acre section	owned and operated by the Marks Family	Longoria, Gainey
Mount Carmel	one of the highest elevation sites in the AVA looking down on Sweeney and just west of Sea Smoke, south and south-west exposures, a windy and very dynamic site	18 acres planted in early 1990's on botella clay, chardonnay is probably of Wente origin, aspect rich and diverse, super low yielding; pinot noir is planted to clones 115 and Mount Eden	leased by Paul Albrecht and Ron Piazza and farmed by John Belfy	ABC, Babcock and Longoria
